

Foster Care Instruction

Thank you for choosing to foster a homeless pet. Opening your home to an animal in need not only assists that animal, but it greatly helps us gain knowledge pertaining to the animal's personality and specific lifestyle

Responsibility of a foster parent:

1. Take care of the animal as if he/she is part of your family and daily life's commitment
2. Provide clean water and fresh food daily and a warm secure place to sleep
3. NEVER remove the animal's collar and tags
4. Write up a profile of the animal's likes and dislikes or suggested needs in its new permanent home.
5. CONTACT us immediately if the animal goes missing or needs medical attention

 **Please do not take your foster to dog parks where they may encounter aggressive dogs.**

Bringing Foster Animal to Adoptions:

1. Let us know immediately if you are unable to continue fostering the animal
2. Let us know the timeframe that you are able to foster the animal
3. If you are unable to bring the animal to the weekly scheduled adoption event please let the coordinator know by the Friday morning prior to the event.
4. **If you choose to adopt the animal in foster, please let us know as soon as your decision is made or at least by the Friday morning prior to the adoption event**
5. Please be prepared to deliver the animal to the adoption event at 9:30 am and pick up from the adoption event at 4 pm
6. If your contact information changes from what was initially provided, please provide us with the current information so that we may advise you if the animal is being adopted and your pick up is not needed; but you may always opt to select another foster animal.
